EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS On September 2, 2007, the body of Demetrius Asa Boone was found in Buck Creek in Macon County, Georgia, with two gunshot wounds to the head; and
- WHEREAS: The Sumter County Sheriff's Office has conducted an investigation and has been unable to generate any solid leads regarding the identity of the perpetrators; and
- WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has committed a felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the murder of Demetrius Asa Boone.
