EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On August 1, 2007, the bodies of Jane, Isabela and Annabelle Kuria were discovered in their home at 4789 Country Cove Way in Powder Springs. All three died of severe head trauma. Jeremy Kuria and a cousin, Peter Thande were also severely beaten. Jeremy is currently in a coma and Peter Thande is currently recovering.

WHEREAS: The Powder Springs Police Department has conducted an investigation and has been unable to generate any solid leads; and

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has committed a felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$3,000.00 (\$1,000 per victim), is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the murders of Jane, Isabela and Annabelle Kuria.
