WHEREAS: Many of them must be removed from their homes and placed in a

safe, stable and loving environment: and

WHEREAS: The Division of Family and Children Services, the state agency

responsible for the well-being of these children, placed and

monitored 15,400 children in foster care in SFY 2004; and

WHEREAS: The success of Georgia's foster care program depends upon the

dedication of those workers and citizens who choose to serve

children; and

WHEREAS: The caseworkers and foster parents of Georgia deserve our respect

and support as crucial members of the state's foster care team; and

WHEREAS: Numerous individuals and public and private organizations work to

support Georgia's foster care program and increase public

awareness of the needs of abuse and neglected children; now

THEREFORE: I, SONNY PERDUE, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby

proclaim May 2005 as FOSTER CARE MONTH in Georgia in recognition of these very caring citizens and the invaluable services

they provide for our most vulnerable children.
