fostering prevention and by integrating the delivery of primary care with aggressive outreach, patient

education, translation and other enabling services; and

high standard of accountability and demonstrating cost-effectiveness and efficiency in the delivery of care. These organizations also empower communities to address unmet health needs and reduce

preventable deaths, costly disabilities and communicable diseases; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Association for Primary Health Care supports President George Bush's goal of increasing the number of health centers in Georgia and across the nation. Our community health centers are

leaders in the national campaign to achieve 100 percent access and zero health disparities. These centers have demonstrated commendable efforts in continuous quality improvement, reduction of health care disparities, networking to maximize and coordinate community resources and utilizing

the latest technology to improve both operations and delivery of services to more Georgians; and
