- WHEREAS: Beef is a traditional American food with a taste that vast numbers of Americans love and appreciate; and
- WHEREAS: Beef is one of our most versatile and nutritious protein sources, with less fat and fewer calories than ever before; and
- WHEREAS: The production of beef cattle is one of Georgia's largest and most important industries, with cattle inventory in Georgia valued in excess of \$676 million, ranking sixth in cash crop receipts in the state; and
- WHEREAS: It is important that the people of Georgia recognize the valuable contributions that our cattle industry makes to the health and well-being of our state: now
- THEREFORE: I, SONNY PERDUE, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 2003 as Georgia Beef Month and urge our citizens to participate in this observance through the support of our local beef industry.
