THEREFORE: I, SONNY PERDUE, Governor of the State of Georgia, do

hereby proclaim September 24, 2003, as FREIGHT RAIL DAY in Georgia and call upon all residents of this great state to join me in recognizing intermodal freight rail for its vital role in our state's economy and our daily

lives.
