WHEREAS: In the spirit of volunteerism, Master Gardeners continue to provide

valuable services to Georgia communities through education and training

programs; now

THEREFORE: I, SONNY PERDUE, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

March 15, 2003, as MASTER GARDENER DAY in Georgia and encourage our
