OPERATION LIFESAVER MONTH

- WHEREAS: Operation Lifesaver is a nationwide public education program to help reduce collisions between motor vehicles and trains; fatalities and injuries at highway/rail grade crossings; and trespassing incidents on railroad tracks and rights-of-way; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Georgia has made great strides in the reduction of these incidents by over 50 percent since the formation of Georgia Operation Lifesaver in 1974; and
- WHEREAS: Many state and local governments, businesses and civic groups have joined Georgia Operation Lifesaver to help educate our citizens about railroad safety; and
- WHEREAS: Special events, including "Operation Lifesaver Night at the Braves" and trespass awareness activities, will be conducted in May throughout Georgia, emphasizing the importance of staying alert at highway/rail intersections and avoiding trespassing; now
- THEREFORE: I, SONNY PERDUE, Governor of the State of Georgia do hereby proclaim May as OPERATION LIFESAVER MONTH in Georgia, and urge all our citizens to drive safely and cautiously when approaching a highway/rail crossing, to obey our laws by always yielding to oncoming trains and to avoid trespassing on railroad tracks and rights-of-way.
