- THEREFORE: I, SONNY PERDUE, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 18-24, 2003, as PUBLIC WORKS WEEK in Georgia and urge citizens to recognize the substantial contribution these services have made to our health and welfare.
