lowa to help inform the nation about playground injuries and possible ways to reduce the number of injuries, has identified key areas that could help substantially reduce the number of playground injuries and keep our children SAFE by providing proper Supervision, Age-appropriate equipment, materials to soften Falls to the

surface, and Equipment maintenance; and

WHEREAS: The National Program for Playground Safety is funded by the Centers for Disease

Control and Prevention, an institution located in Atlanta, Georgia, and committed to

protecting the health and safety of people; and

WHEREAS: It is appropriate to set aside a week each year to contemplate and discuss ways to

keep our children safe on playgrounds, and spring is often a time that children head to the playground, and since all of us who care about children are committed

to keeping our children safe; and

WHEREAS: The National Program for Playground Safety has designated April 21–25, 2003, as

National Playground Safety Week; now

THEREFORE: I, Sonny Perdue, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim the week of

April 21-25, 2003, as PLAYGROUND SAFETY WEEK in Georgia and urge all citizens

to join in this important observance.
