- THEREFORE: I, SONNY PERDUE, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 4, 2003, as PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEES DAY in Georgia and do urge all citizens to show their appreciation for the brave service of our state's public safety employees.
