need help with basic necessities such as housing, food, medical care and utility services. The program assists the elderly, the disabled, the unemployed, the sick and others who

are in need of a helping hand; and

WHEREAS: Project Share is administered by the Salvation Army and is

funded by electric utility customers who donate through their monthly electric bills. All contributions are forwarded to the Salvation Army and allocated for assistance in the county

where the donation was made; and

WHEREAS: Georgia's electric utility companies and the Salvation Army are

excellent examples of businesses and charitable organizations working together to help solve a community problem, and it is indeed appropriate to recognize them for their cooperative

efforts to help our state's needy citizens; now

THEREFORE: I, SONNY PERDUE, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby

proclaim August 4, 2003, as SHARE DAY in Georgia and urge

our citizens to support this important endeavor.
