## **EXECUTIVE ORDER**

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

There currently exists at Middle Georgia College, Laurens County, Dublin, Georgia, structures known as Houses, Grounds Building, Pool, Pool-house, Utility Building, and Tennis Courts (the "Structures"); and

WHEREAS:

The Board of Regents', at its meeting on April 14, 2009, declared by resolution that said Structures can no longer be advantageously used by Middle Georgia College or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed; and

WHEREAS:

It is the opinion of Ms. Linda M. Daniels, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that the Structures can no longer be advantageously used by Middle Georgia College or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Governor of the State of Georgia, it is hereby

**ORDERED:** 

That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Structures from Middle Georgia College, Laurens County, Dublin, Georgia.

## IT IS FURTHER

**ORDERED:** 

That the appropriate staff of Middle Georgia College, Laurens County, Dublin, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Structures and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
