EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 10.095 acres in the City of Cave Spring, Floyd County (the "Property"), known as the Cave Spring Rehabilitation Center, as described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS: Structures located on the Property (the "Structures") were declared unserviceable by the Georgia Commissioner of Labor on July 28, 2010, and Georgia Department of Labor has no plans to use the Structures for any future purpose; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Department of Labor has federal grant funding available to raze and demolish said structures and to renovate the property; and

WHEREAS: By letter dated July 28, 2010, the Commissioner of the Georgia Department of Labor has requested permission to raze and demolish said structures as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Georgia Department of Labor is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structures under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia.
