EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to 5.557 acres in Rockdale County known as the Drivers Services' Headquarters and State Patrol Post 46 (the "Property"), and the Georgia Department of Public Safety ("DPS") is the custodian of the Property; and
- WHEREAS:** The custody of 0.52 acres of the Property was transferred from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation ("GBI") to the DPS in 1990 for use by DPS as an off-street Drivers License Test Course; and
- WHEREAS:** The custody of an additional 1.02 acres of the Property was transferred from GBI to DPS in 1999 to enlarge the off-street Drivers License Test Course; and
- WHEREAS:** That these aforementioned 0.52 acre and 1.02 acre parcels are located adjacent to the GBI building at 2148 Iris Drive in Conyers and contain a total of 1.54 acres as identified and described in the survey attached as Exhibit A (the "Premises"); and
- WHEREAS:** On December 11, 2008, the Georgia Board of the Public Safety (i) determined that the DPS has no plans to use the Premises and will at no time in the future have any need or use of the Premises, and (ii) approved the transfer of the Premises to the custody and control of the GBI for all purposes; and
- WHEREAS:** The GBI is desirous of using the Premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

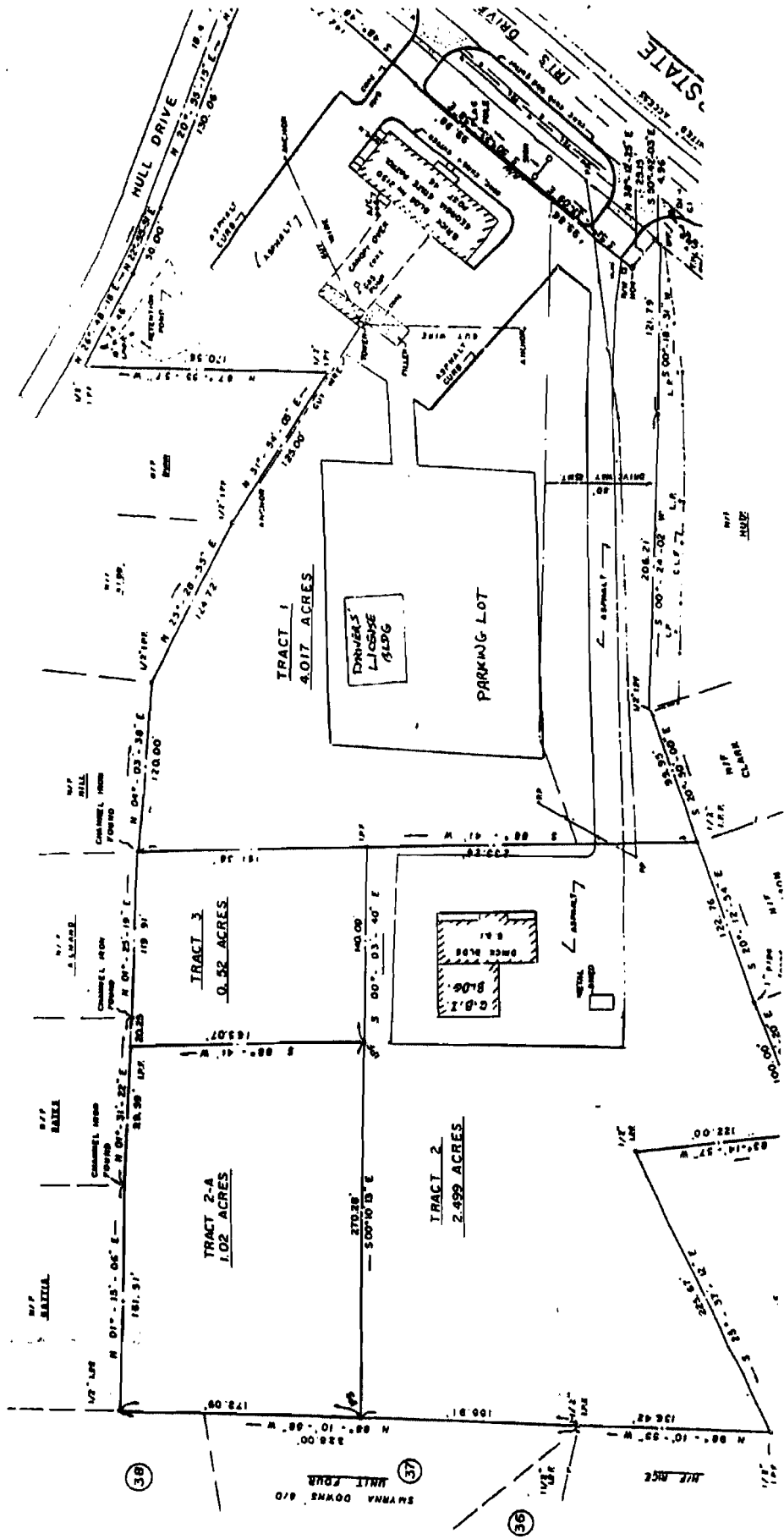
ORDERED: That the custody of the Premises be and the same is hereby transferred from the Department of Public Safety to the Georgia Bureau of Investigation.
