EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exist at the Georgia Institute of Technology, Fulton County, Atlanta,

Georgia, buildings known as Mechanical Engineering Research Building (#48), 676 Mechanical Engineering Drive; Army ROTC Office Building (#23A), and Army ROTC

Armory Building (#23B), 220 Bobby Dodd Way (the "Buildings"); and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents at its meeting on April 21, 2010, declared by resolution that said

Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by the Georgia Institute of Technology

or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed; and

WHEREAS: It is the opinion of Ms. Linda M. Daniels, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of the Board of

Regents of the University System of Georgia, that the Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by the Georgia Institute of Technology or the University System of

Georgia and should be demolished and removed.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Governor of the State of

GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to

demolish and remove the Buildings from the Georgia Institute of Technology, Fulton

County, Atlanta, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of the Georgia Institute of Technology, Fulton County, Atlanta,

Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and
