EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:	The State of Georgia holds title to $112\pm$ acres known as the Lorenzo Benn Youth Development Campus and associated property, and the Georgia Department of Juvenile Justice ("DJJ") is the custodian of said property as described in Exhibit A (the "Premises") in the City of Atlanta, Fulton County; and
WHEREAS:	The Georgia DJJ no longer operates the Lorenzo Benn Youth Development Campus or the associated property and has no plans to use the Premises for any other purposes; and
WHEREAS:	The Georgia Department of Defense is desirous of locating and operating an administrative, training, and storage facility at the now defunct Lorenzo Benn Youth Development Campus; and
WHEREAS:	On October 2, 2008, the Adjutant General of the Georgia Department of Defense requested the transfer of custody and control of the Premises from the DJJ to the custody and control of the Georgia Department of Defense for the purposes of operating an administrative, training, and storage facility.
WHEREAS:	On December 11, 2008, The Georgia Board of Juvenile Justice approved and accepted the transfer of custody and control of the Premises from DJJ to the Georgia Department of Defense and authorized the DJJ Commissioner to effect such a change.
	Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Georgia, it is hereby
ORDERED:	That the custody of the above-described property be and the same is hereby transferred


ORDERED: That the custody of the above-described property be and the same is hereby transferred from the Department of Juvenile Justice to the Georgia Department of Defense.
