EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

O.C.G.A. § 37-2-32(d) provides that the Disability Services Ombudsman

shall serve terms of five years; and

WHEREAS:

O.C.G.A. § 37-2-32(a) requires the appointment of a nominating committee to consider nominees for the position of the ombudsman and that such nominating committee recommend at least three candidates to serve as

ombudsman.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED

IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS

HEREBY

ORDERED:

That a nominating committee of Mary Burns, Nora Lott Haynes, Tommy Hills, Vernon Keenan, Sharon McDaniel, Don Meck, and Gwen Skinner be formed to consider nominees for the position of ombudsman as required by O.C.G.A. § 37-2-32. The nominating committee shall recommend for consideration at least three persons with knowledge and experience concerning the safety, well-being, and rights of consumers and shall have

the skills to perform the duties of ombudsman as provided for in

O.C.G.A. § 37-2-35.
