EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Article I, Section IV of the Voluntary Compliance Agreement between the State of Georgia and the United States Department of Health and Human Services Office for Civil Rights (the "Agreement") provides for the appointment of an Olmstead Planning Committee (the "OPC"); and

WHEREAS: An Executive Order dated July 15, 2008 created the OPC and appointed Mr. Abel Ortiz as its chairman; and

WHEREAS: The Agreement provides that the majority of the OPC's membership shall consist of non-State officials, including consumers and advocates; and

WHEREAS: The Agreement provides that the OPC shall approve the State's Olmstead Plan within seven months after the July 1, 2008 execution of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the following individuals are hereby appointed as members of the Olmstead Planning Committee and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor: (1) Lynnette Bragg; (2) Glen Friedman; (3) Neil Kaltenecker; (4) Thomas Martin; (5) Heidi J. Moore; (6) Deirdre O'Brien; (7) Stacey Ramirez; (8) Debbie Reece; (9) Julie Spores; and (10) Amanda Spencer.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the OPC shall approve the State's Olmstead Plan within seven months after the July 1, 2008 execution of the Agreement. The OPC shall issue the Annual Olmstead Report (as defined in the Agreement) each December. The OPC shall regularly receive reports regarding the State's progress in meeting the goals of the Olmstead Plan and the Annual Olmstead Report.
