EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

	Due to the anticipated impact and damages of Hurricanes Hanna & Ike, specific authorization to lift certain restrictions for commercial truck tractor semi-trailer and other types of motor vehicles is warranted; and
WHEREAS:	It is requested that the State of Georgia allow vehicles transporting emergency temporary housing, equipment and supplies by or on behalf of the states of Florida, South Carolina, and North Carolina, to travel on pre-approved state maintained roadways unless sustaining a posted bridge, to issue and provide permits for travel; and
WHEREAS:	Authorization of the Georgia Department of Transportation to issue permits accommodating the movement of vehicles and loads as stated above with coordination and cooperation from law enforcement of the Georgia Department of Public Safety Motor Carrier Compliance Division is warranted.
	NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS COVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA IT IS
	Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Georgia, it is hereby
ORDERED:	IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS

(B) Transporters are responsible for ensuring they have proper permits, oversize signs, markings, flags and escorts as defined in the Georgia Department of Transportation Rules and Regulations (GDOT Rule 672-2-.06 and 672-2-.07).

Permits may be issued by the Georgia Department of Transportation, Oversize Permit Unit, during normal business hours from 7:00 a.m. to 4:45 p.m., Monday through Friday by calling 1-800-570-5428.

This Executive Order shall be valid until October 2, 2008.
