EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On March 22, 2010, I delivered a letter to Attorney General

Thurbert Baker requesting that he institute and prosecute in the name of the State a legal challenge to the newly enacted federal

healthcare legislation; and

WHEREAS: On March 24, 2010, Attorney General Thurbert Baker declined to

represent the State in this matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME

AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Frank C. Jones be appointed Special Attorney General to

represent the State in a challenge to the newly enacted federal

healthcare legislation.

BE IT FURTHER

Ordered: That Mike Russ, Jason Alloy, Josh Belinfante, John Parker, Keith

Blackwell, Pitts Carr, and David Oedel be appointed deputy Special Attorneys General to represent the State in a challenge to the newly

enacted federal healthcare legislation.
