EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

There currently exists at the University of Georgia, Griffin Campus, Spalding County, Griffin, Georgia, buildings known as Horticulture Control (Building #4456) and Irrigation Control, (Building #4497) (the "Buildings"); and

WHEREAS:

The Board of Regents' Policy 909.03 DEMOLITION authorizes the Chancellor of Vice Chancellor for Facilities to declare buildings, structures and other improvements no longer advantageously useful to the University System of Georgia. Said buildings are included within this policy; and

WHEREAS:

It is the opinion of Ms. Linda M. Daniels, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that the Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by the University of Georgia, Griffin Campus or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Governor of the State of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED:

That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Buildings from the University of Georgia, Griffin Campus, Spalding County, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED:

That the appropriate staff of the University of Georgia, Griffin Campus, Spalding County, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
