EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

The Honorable Robert W. Lavender, in his official capacity as District Attorney of the Northern Judicial Circuit, has been named as a party defendant in the lawsuit *Christopher M. Cantwell, Donna G. Adams, Brandon Ransom, Mitchell Major, and Bobby Gunter v. Mack Crawford*, et al., Civil Action Case No. 09EV275M, Superior Court of Elbert County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS:

The Attorney General, because of a conflict, has declined representation of Mr. Lavendar in this case; and

WHEREAS:

Mr. John C. Jones has agreed to represent the Honorable Robert Lavender in this matter at a rate mutually agreed upon by the Prosecuting Attorneys' Council of Georgia and Mr. Jones.

Now, therefore, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-15-70 and the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED:

That Mr. John C. Jones is hereby appointed as Special Counsel to assume control and responsibility for the representation of the Honorable Robert L. Lavendar in all matters related to *Christopher M. Cantwell, Donna G. Adams, Brandon Ransom, Mitchell Major, and Bobby Gunter v. Mack Crawford,* et al., Civil Action Case No. 09EV275M.
