EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On May 22, 2008, an Executive Order was issued which in part transferred \$2,796,879 in state general funds and \$4,869,756 in federal funds appropriated for the Children and Youth Coordinating Council to the Governor's Office for Children and Families; and

WHEREAS: On May 14, 2008, \$600,000 of the state general fund appropriation for the Children and Youth Coordinating Council was vetoed leaving a state general funds appropriation of \$2,196,879.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That as of July 1, 2008, the Children's Trust Fund Commission will transfer \$7,291,902 in state general funds, \$389,692 in other funds, and \$2,336,481 in federal funds, 4 positions and associated equipment to the Governor's Office for Children and Families. As of July 1, 2008, the Children and Youth Coordinating Council will transfer \$2,196,879 in state general funds, \$4,869,756 in federal funds, 4 positions, 1 motor vehicle and associated equipment to the Governor's Office for Children and Families.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: As of July 1, 2008, the Georgia Child Fatality Review Panel will transfer \$379,815 in state general funds, \$72,534 in non-state funds, 3 positions, and associated equipment to the Child Advocate for the Protection of Children.
