## **EXECUTIVE ORDER**

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

## **AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER**

WHEREAS: On July 5, 2005, Lancelot "Sean" Summersett was shot multiple times in

200 Block of Columbia Lane, in Lyons Georgia. Mr. Summersett died at

the scene and his body was not discovered for some time.

WHEREAS: The incident is currently being investigated by both the Lyons Police

Department and the Georgia Bureau of Investigation but they have been

unable to generate any solid leads.

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that -

the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has

committed a felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That an increase in the amount of \$500.00, is hereby offered for

information leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the murder of Lancelot "Sean" Summersett,

bringing the total amount of the Governor's Reward to \$2,000.00
