EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS: Article I, Section II of the Voluntary Compliance Agreement between the State of Georgia and the United States Department of Health and Human Services Office for Civil Rights provides for the appointment of an Olmstead Coordinator; and
- WHEREAS: The primary task of the Olmstead Coordinator will be to coordinate the State's compliance with the Voluntary Compliance Agreement, to include hearing and addressing Olmstead-related problems, and developing and implementing Georgia's Olmstead Plan objectives.

Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED: That Mr. Abel Ortiz is hereby appointed to serve as the Olmstead Coordinator for the State of Georgia, and shall be responsible for the coordination of the State's compliance with the Voluntary Compliance Agreement.
