EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: Every day, in every area of the United States of America, a

very special group of men and women are called upon to protect their communities and fellow citizens as law

enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS: We, as a grateful people, owe a debt of gratitude to all those

in varying capacities of law enforcement who have answered

the call "To Protect and To Serve"; and

WHEREAS: By a joint resolution approved October 1, 1962, the President

of the United States of America has been authorized and requested to designate May 15 of each year as "Peace Officers' Memorial Day" and the week in which it falls as "Police Week," and to direct that the flag be flown at half

staff on Peace Officers' Memorial Day.

Now, therefore, in honor and as a mark of respect for the officers who serve, and in memory of the officers who have fallen, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of

GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flags on all state buildings throughout the state of

Georgia be flown at half staff on Thursday, May 15, 2008.
